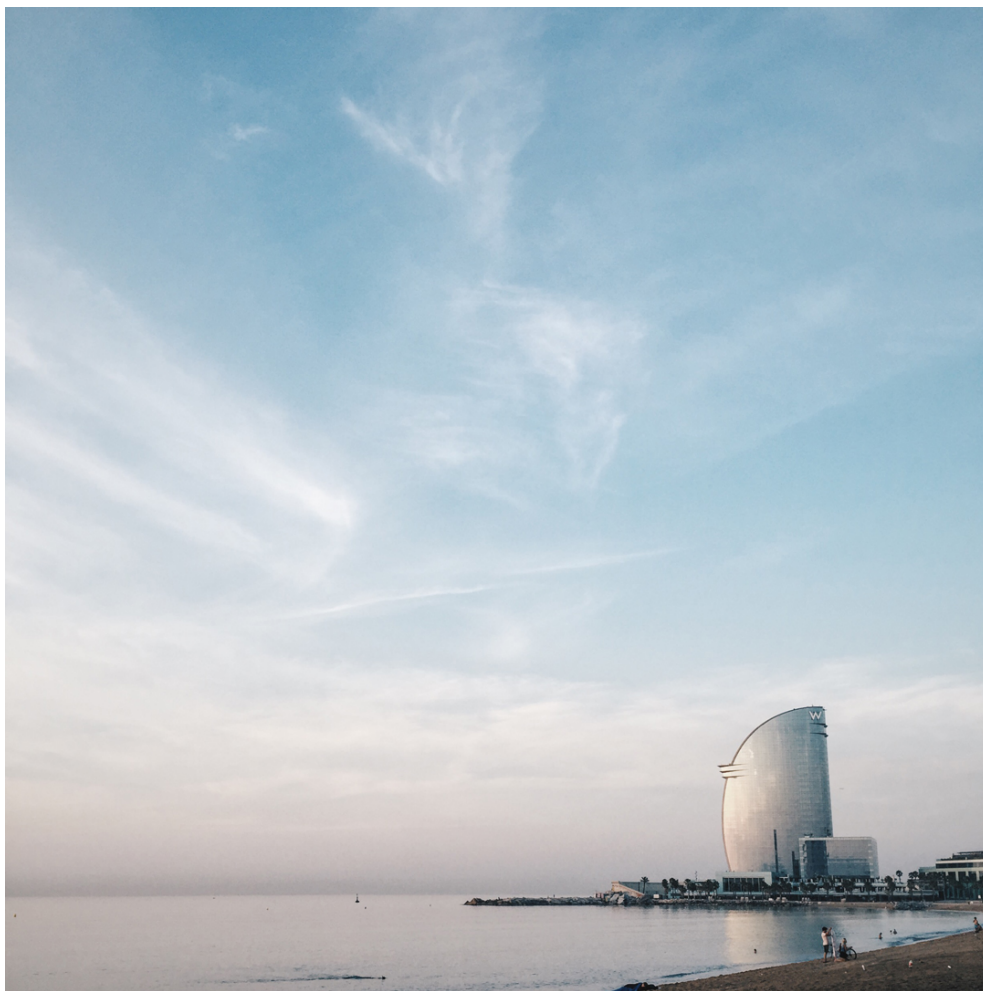




TRAVEL

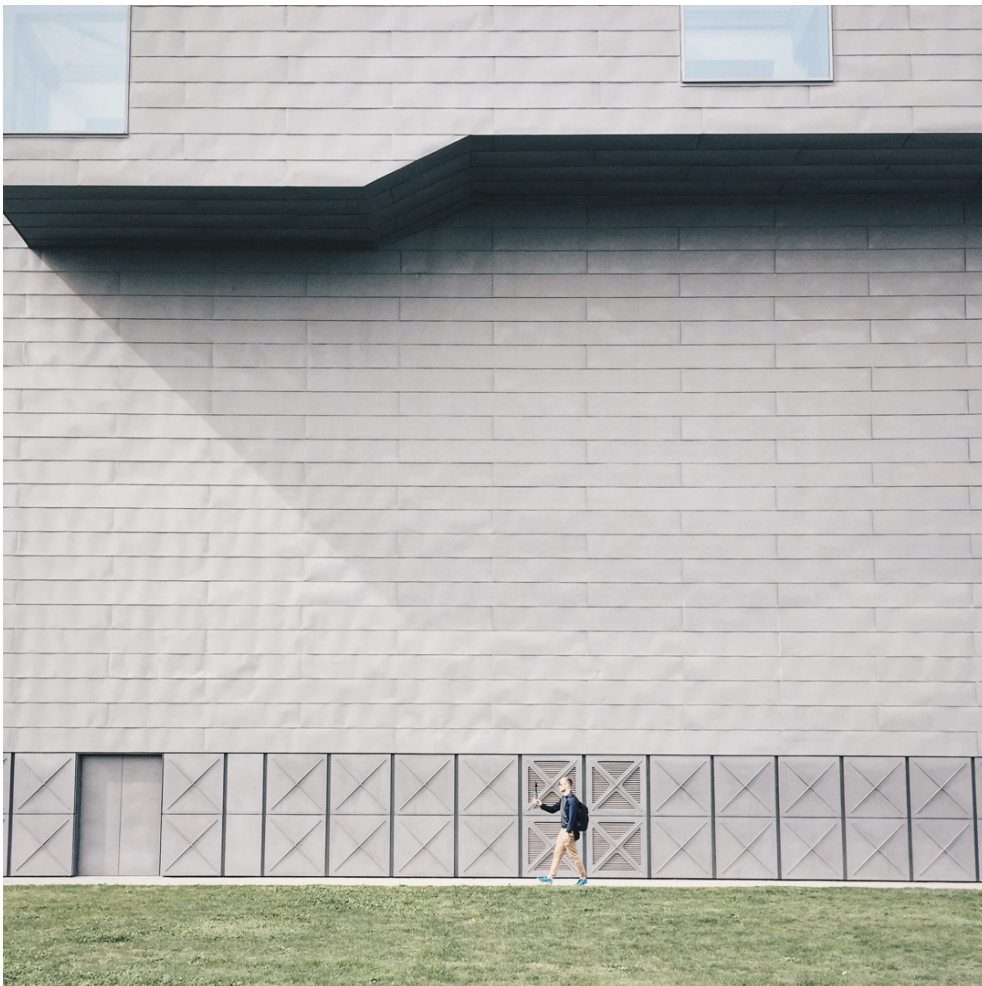
Before it gets too hot, its time for sightseeing. I suggest you go to Antoni Gaudi's **Park Güell**, it is just one of the many beautiful must-see icons of Barcelona. If you want something more modern design, head to **Museu del Disseny de Barcelona**, the building itself is amazing, and you might be lucky that the museum show something cool too.



After all that walking and sightseeing, the body needs food. Make your way to El Cercle. It is not cheap, but I think, you should at least have one super delicious over the top meal a day, when you are on holiday right? You have the option of sitting outside on the terrace, it might be too warm, if so, ask for a table in the library. Go for the tasting seven-course menu.



After a long lunch, if you decide on that tasting menu, you might not be able to do much more. If you do, allow yourself a wander around the area, you find a lot of small cute shops, sunny squares or you might even want to walk the famous Les Rambles (not something I really recommend), just to check that of the bucket list. Hold on to your coins and phones, as many do tend to have very long fingers on this street, in other words, be very aware of pickpockets.



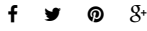
lively and crowded atmosphere. Sitting at one of their high tables or at the bar and remember to order the tuna tartar, it is not only perfect but also so beautifully presented.

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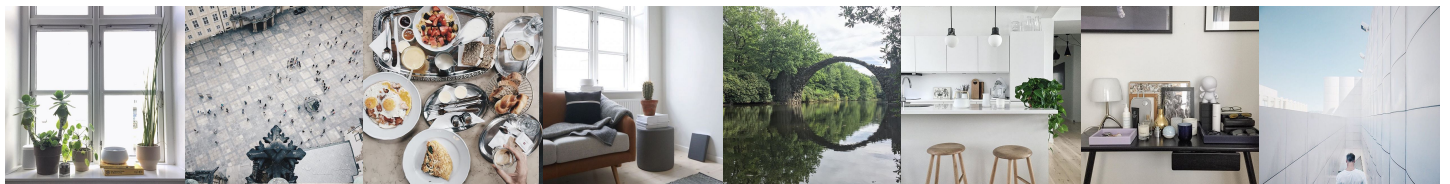
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
